Breeder Hacks – Hair Here, Hair There, Hair Everywhere – BEST SOLUTIONS EVER!

- 1. We own multiple shedding dogs. We have NO free-floating hair and I like to keep a tidy house. Here are multiple things I use that make this totally possible.
 - a. My favorite for rugs, is this hair removing tool called **Uproot clean Pro**, again, that can be found on Amazon. You may have to experiment with different ones that will work with you depending on the types of rugs and furniture you have. I prefer a large size one and a small size one. I combine scraping hair with running the vacuum over the clumps of hair that I had extracted. Saves so much time.



2. Next, I use **OneIsAll** a de-shedding and grooming tool with a very quiet vacuum attachment and blow dryer all in one. None of our dogs are scared of this one and it comes with a de-shedding brush with a vacuum (so no mess!).



3. Lastly, **we have TWO self-emptying Roombas** *scheduled to run 3 times a week,* one downstairs and one upstairs. Those are more for the dirt tracked into the house rather

than the hair. The de-shedding tool is going to eliminate that problem to where you won't have to use the brush or vacuum for it very often.

4. The good news with Aussies and Collies is they go through seasonal shedding so its not ALL the time. Late summer and spring are usually when they need their coats blown.
